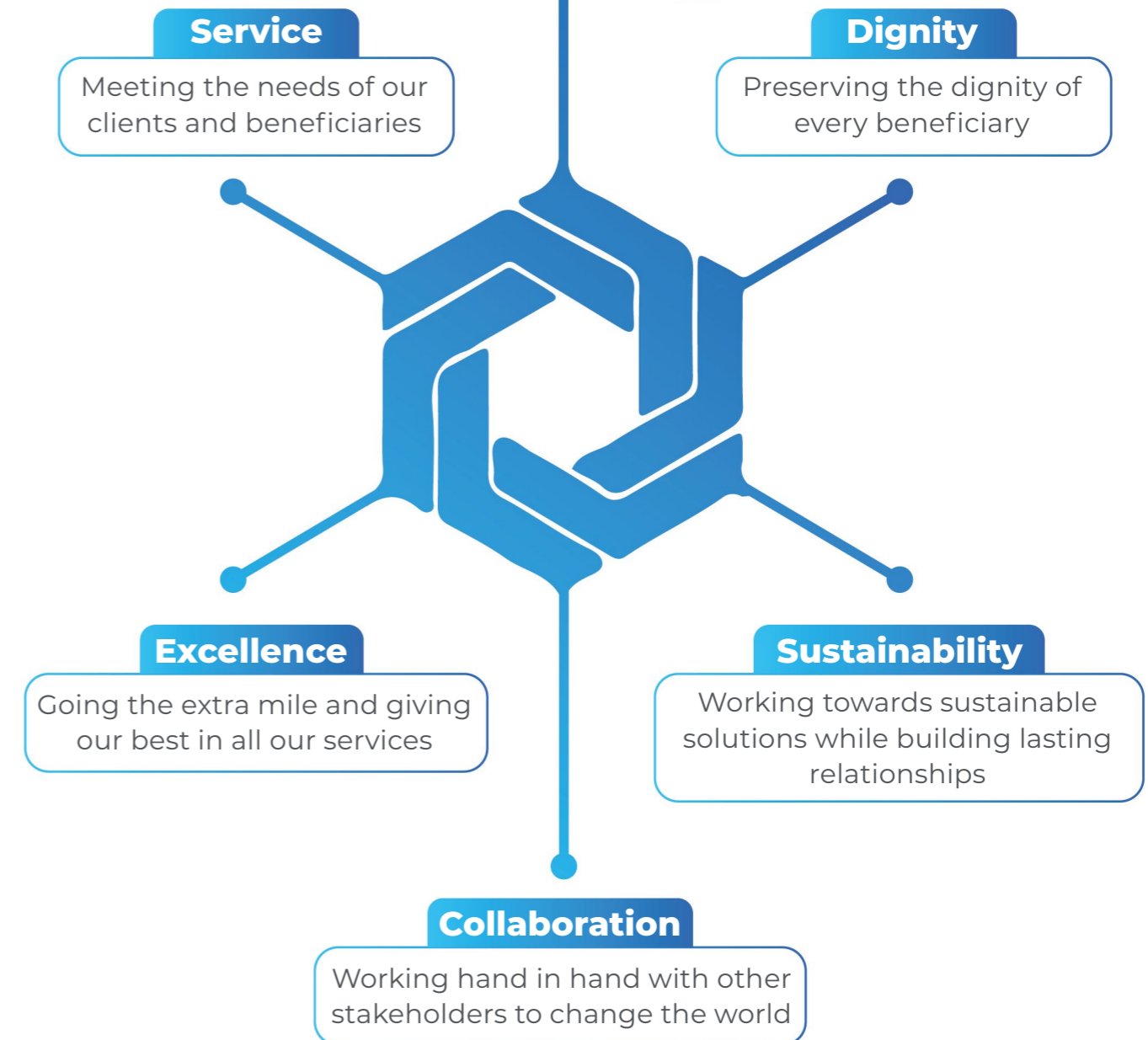

Our global reach

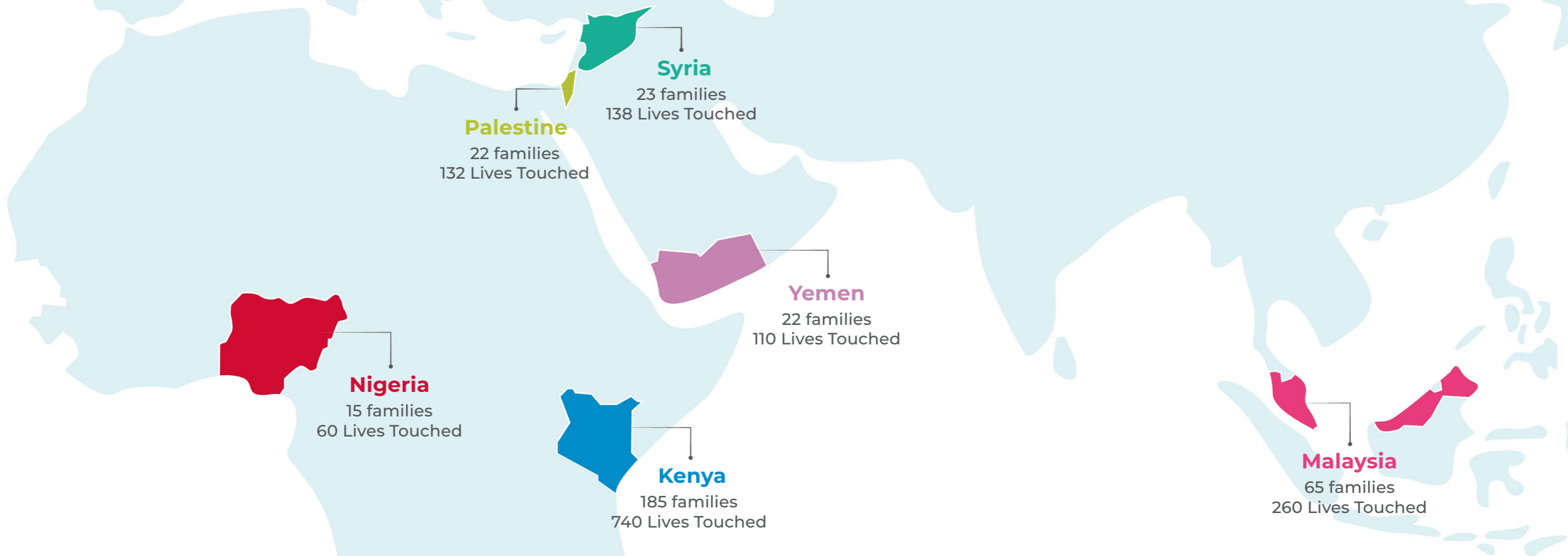

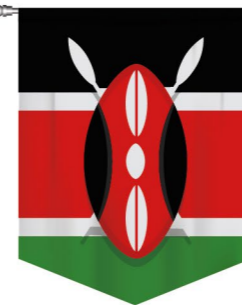
With the permission of ALLAH, manifesting through your support, and the diligent efforts of our partners on the ground, together we were able to serve a total 6 communities in Malaysia, Palestine, Yemen, Syria, Kenya & Nigeria.

Below is a brief insight into the communities reached this year.



Malaysia

Along with our partners from the United Arakan Institute of Malaysia (UAIM). We were able to facilitate the distribution of Qurban meat to over 65 Rohingya Refugee families residing in the Puchong Area, Selangor, Malaysia.



Kenya

Alhamdulillah, we were able to support over 185 families in the rural community of Tiwi, Kiteje, Mswambeni and Ngombeni, Kenya.

We were fortunate to have our partner, AFECOD, on the ground to help identify some of the most vulnerable communities and support in the slaughtering and distribution of the meat.



Nigeria

We were honored to be given the opportunity to serve a total of 15 families in the rural communities of Gawobe and Chibiri whose Muslim inhabitants are recent reverts to Islam. The meat packages they recieved were more than just much needed food support but a sign of solidarity from their Muslim brethren across the globe.

Our partners at Amanah Educational Foundation (AEF) and The Federation of Muslim Women Association of Nigeria (FOMWAN) helped to make this possible.



Palestine

The distribution in Palestine, benefited a total of 22 families in the Gaza strip. Our partner on the ground (CR) helped to ensure that the meat reached the most deserving families.



Syria

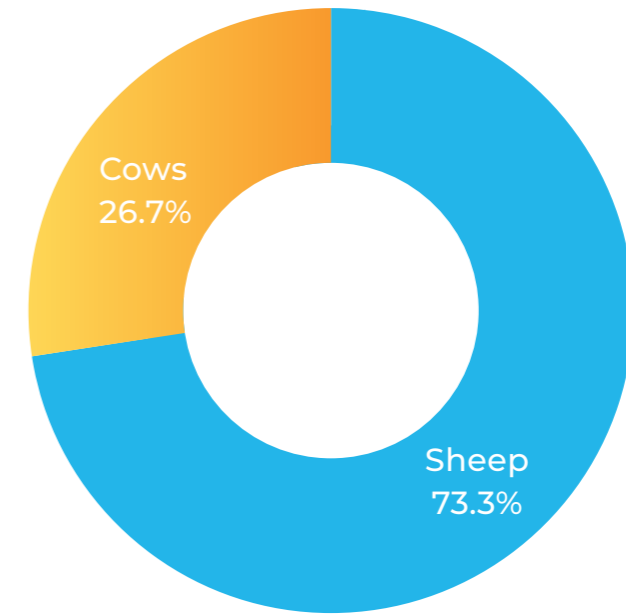

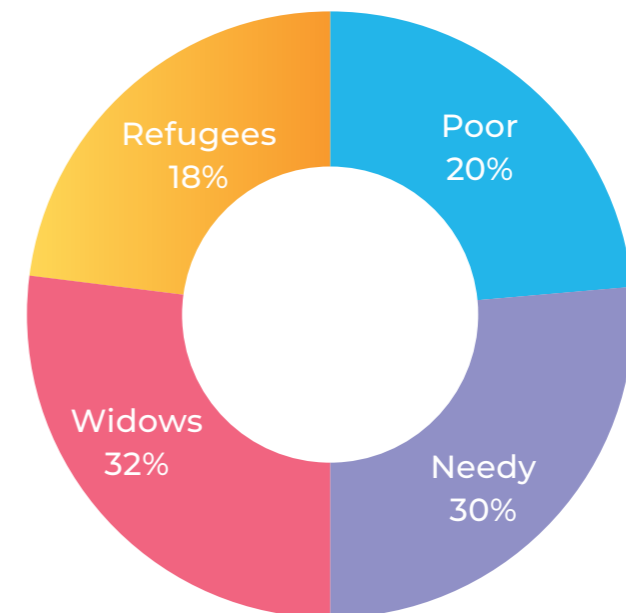
Yemen

Recipient demographics



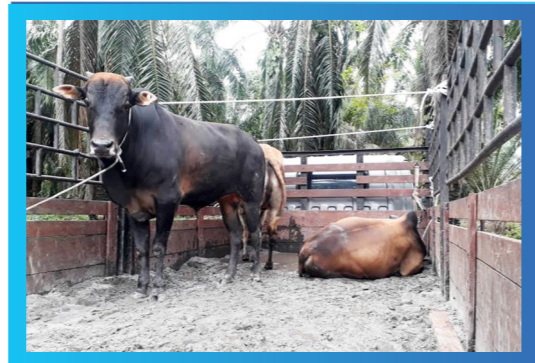
